## **SPECIFICATIONS**

- 1. In Lieu of Landscape Plan, provide the following minimum landscape maintenance requirements.
  - a. A two-year plant replacement warranty and two years of maintenance are required by the County.
  - b. Lawn areas shall be moved to a height of 2 to 3 inches and not allowed to reach a height of 4 inches before mowing.
  - c. All curbs and walks shall be edged as needed.
  - d. All lawn areas adjacent to building faces or structures shall be trimmed.
  - e. A slow-release nitrogen balanced fertilizer with a 2-1-1 ratio shall be applied at a rate of 2 pounds of nitrogen per 1000 square feet in September, October and February.
  - f. Lime shall be applied at the rate determined by a soils report.
  - g. It is recommended that lawn areas be treated in mid-March to early April with a preemergent herbicide (between) or equal applied at the manufacture's rate.
  - h. A post-emergent herbicide (Trimec) or equal is recommended to be sprayed on lawn areas in the late spring or early fall. Follow manufacturer's rates and recommendations.
  - i. Insecticides and fungicides are recommended for insect and disease control.
  - j. Reseed bare areas of lawn as necessary. Yearly aeration is recommended.
- 2. Seeding mix over disturbed soils.
  - a. Contractor to establish grass once construction is complete, all disturbed areas to be reseeded with seed mix containing Kentucky 31 or Tury-Type Tall Fescue (95-100%), Improved perennial ryegrass (0-5%), and Kentucky Bluegrass (0-5%).
